Description: This serene, oceanfront layout rests along the bluffs of the California Riviera, with two consecutive holes (No. 3 and No. 4) running right along the Pacific that make this a "must play" Southern California experience.

Playing between a welcoming 5,000 yards and a championship-caliber 6,600 yards, this par 70 has the classic Robert Trent Jones Jr. design theme of providing golfers of all skill levels an enjoyable and engaging challenge.

Renovated in 2001, tight manicured fairways and smallish, undulating greens, as well as immaculate conditions, beautiful flower beds and flash faced white sand bunkers continue to define the course experience.

The course meanders inland through an upscale resort and residential community. The first nine finishes with four holes bordered by a devilish arroyo with a creek running through it. The back nine ambles into a sunny valley as it leads to the invigorating No. 18, which is distinctly influenced by water.

Practice Area: A practice putting green and adjacent hitting bays provide the opportunity to work on your short game and get your swing warmed up.

- **Golf Butler:** This exemplary forecaddie program is designed to enhance every golf experience. Each Golf Butler has been trained, with knowledge of the game and nuances of the golf course. The Golf Butler accompanies the assigned the group for the entire round, performing all the customary duties of a professional caddie, including:
 - Providing yardage distances
 - Helping with club selection
 - Reading the sometimes tricky greens
 - Pointing out hazards
 - Locating golf balls
 - Raking sand bunkers, replacing divots, cleaning clubs
 - Tending flagstick, repairing ball marks, cleaning the golf balls
 - Handling food, beverage, cigar, tobacco and merchandise orders
 - \$65 (per player) \$250 (per foursome)
