Kids tend to gravitate to the American-style 1950's Diner, which serves hot dogs, hamburgers and milkshakes; La Heladeria, featuring 24 flavors of homemade ice cream and gelato; and La Creperia, which turns out the best crepes (sweet or savory) in Los Cabos. The Market is also home to a few other culinary outposts favored by the younger set, including El Deli (delicious sandwiches), El Italiano (brick-oven pizzas) and El Mexicano (Mexican favorites).

Sunset Beach, a popular choice for families that offers private beach access, six swimming pools and a playground, opened several new restaurants in 2016, one of them geared to sophisticated younger guests. For example, kids with adventurous palates can sample the fare at Tazuna, a year-old "sunsets-and-sushi" outpost at Sunset Beach that features delectable Mexican versions of classic Japanese sushi and sashimi dishes.

In addition, the Sunset Beach Kids Clubs welcomes younger guests to enjoy fun-filled days, with arts and crafts, board games, pool games and movies available. Life-enriching activities range from Spanish language primers and aqua aerobics to cooking classes and dance lessons led by top instructors. Kids can also join their parents on the resort's tennis courts and beach volleyball courts.

Older siblings (ages 12 to 19) can check out the 3,600-square-foot, urban-themed Fun Lab at Sunset Beach, a lounge and recreation center built expressly for hard-to-please teenagers. The certifiably "cool" Fun Lab offers several peso-operated games, including billiards, foosball, air hockey, arcade games and the latest edition of PlayStation, among other age-appropriate entertainments. There's also access to a cozy 35-person movie theater. The menu at Fun Lab has "teenager" written all over it. There's a soda fountain. Nachos. Pizza. Hot dogs. Popcorn. Ice cream. And other teenager-approved snack and food items. That sound you hear outside Villa 45, the location of Fun Lab? It's the sound of teenagers laughing, having fun and most of all not complaining about another boring family vacation.
