Two-thirds of the talented WAS instructors have been certified by the Professional Ski Instructors of America or the American Association of Snowboard Instructors.

Adaptive lessons include lift ticket, equipment, and private instruction, typically with a minimum of two instructors. All new students must complete a student participant form designed to help WAS match each person with the appropriate instructors. In the summer, WAS offers kayaking, canoeing and adaptive golf clinics. WAS is a chapter of Disabled Sports USA and a Paralympic sports club.
