Wintergreen is the only ski area on the East Coast where 100 percent of the terrain is covered by automated snowmaking. The result is "gold standard" skiing and snowboarding surfaces, with uniformity of depth and consistency of snow from the top of the slopes to the bottom.

Ski lift tickets for adults start a \$49 for a four-hour session Monday-Friday to \$84 for an 8-hour session on holidays; tickets for seniors and youths run from \$39-\$64.

Wintergreen's Terrain Park offers freestyle skiers and snowboarders a wide range of features for all abilities levels, from tabletops to fun boxes, spines and hips, straight rails, rainbow rails, battleships, downkinks, and s-rails. Features frequently change throughout the season to offer new challenges.

Wintergreen Resort accommodations are ideal for any and every group, including families, groups of friends, and couples. Options include 230 villa-style condominiums and rental homes –from studio suites to nine-bedroom homes—each offering a fully equipped kitchen and comfortable living area, and most come with fireplaces and a balcony or deck.
