On an island where golf is king, Harbour Town Golf Links is true royalty, and along with the highly acclaimed Heron Point and the all-new Atlantic Dunes—ranked 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> on Hilton Head Island by Golfweek magazine—the three courses place The Sea Pines Resort among the most desirable golf destinations in the world.

Harbour Town Golf Links remains the hands-down No. 1 golf attraction on Hilton Head Island. Designed by legendary golf architect Pete Dye, with Jack Nicklaus as consultant, the long-time venue for South Carolina's only PGA Tour event is largely responsible for the region's stellar reputation for great golf.

Pete Dye also redesigned Heron Point, turning it into an essential component of any Sea Pines Resort golf vacation. Heron Point is a combination of charm and challenge, with strategic risk-reward shot selections, rolling fairways, and shifting elevations that come together to create a fun experience.

Atlantic Dunes is a complete reconstruction of the Ocean Course, which was the first course built on Hilton Head Island. Davis Love III kept the original routing while emphasizing the beachfront ambience and unmistakable Lowcountry feel. Each hole was entirely rebuilt to accommodate modern shot values.

All three courses have achieved designation as Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuaries.

Situated on the southernmost tip of Hilton Head Island, The Sea Pines Resort features five miles of unspoiled beaches, 21 clay tennis courts, 14 miles of bike and walking trails, horseback riding, Eco-Adventures, water sports, and the 605-acre Sea Pines Forest Preserve, which is rich in wildflowers, wetlands, and more than 130 species of birds. As the first Eco-planned destination in the U.S., The Sea Pines Resort has become the blueprint for numerous beach developments around the country.
