Weston Hills has hosted the PGA Honda Classic (1992-1995), the Dan Marino Celebrity Invitational (1992-2001), the LPGA Chrysler Plymouth Tournament of Champions (1997), and continues to host various USGA qualifying events.

The club also has eight lighted Har-Tru tennis courts, a heated outdoor swimming pool, and children's wading area. The 50,000-square-foot clubhouse boasts a beautiful member dining room and bar overlooking the golf courses, perfect for enjoying a cozy family dinner or entertaining friends and business associates. Private rooms for up to 300+ guests accommodate special events, receptions, banquets, and meetings.
