


## THE RESERVE CLUB UNVEILS CLUBHOUSE RENOVATION

The clubhouse transformation includes a complete redesign of the interior, additions of new dining and entertainment experiences, and architectural renovations encompassing a multipurpose alfresco kitchen, extensive new bar and casual spaces, and improved special event areas, all which provide for more gathering, dining, and socializing opportunities.

The new dining and social spaces highlight the club's magnificent views of the Coachella Valley, surrounding mountain ranges, and award-winning Tom Weiskopf/Jay Morrish-designed golf course. Larger, more contemporary windows and doors connect the outdoors with in, while opening onto newly expanded patios.

The existing Tuscan architecture has been maintained while being updated with new flooring, fixtures, unique pieces of art, and a mix of modern and traditional furniture. The feeling of casual elegance extends throughout the building and is meant to make members feel as comfortable as they are in their own homes.

Developers Robert J. Lowe and Ted R. Lennon of Lowe Enterprises began visualizing a special place in the Valley close to both the Santa Rosa Mountains and Palm Desert activities back in the 1980s. From the beginning, Lowe and Lennon were committed to protecting and enhancing the sensitive desert ecosystem, and it took 10 years of planning, permitting, and careful construction to open the club in November 1998. Now in its 20<sup>th</sup> year, the club's transformation has brought a new vibrancy to the lifestyle.

The center of club life then and now is The Reserve Club Village, anchored by the Clubhouse with its dining venues and lounges, terraces, wine cellar, bar, library, and men's and women's locker rooms. The Club Village also comprises a Fitness Center, Golf Shop, and the Lakehouse for casual dining.

The club also recently revitalized its golf course irrigation system. The Reserve has always prided itself on presenting premium fairway turf conditions and, rare for the desert, the highest quality bentgrass greens. Outfitting the course with the latest irrigation technology ensures optimal playing conditions while reducing water use.

But some things will never change. Holding true to the guiding principles set down by Lowe, Lennon, and the other Founding Members, The Reserve remains dedicated to familiarity and friendship, promoting an active lifestyle for an exclusive yet involved membership, and protecting the natural desert environment.

The club offers golf and social memberships for both residents of The Reserve and non-residents seeking to enjoy the amenities, events and activities, personalized service, and camaraderie.
