The event begins Sunday evening (Sept. 15) with a welcome cocktail reception saluting Mexico's independence, officially celebrated on Sept. 16. On that day in 1810, the 11-year Mexican War of Independence with Spain started. For the remainder of the festivities, Mexican culinary specialties, flavors, and traditions will be infused into the program.

The 4,447-acre resort sits on a sprawling stretch of white-sand beach along Danzante Bay, where the natural habitat includes 900 species of fish. Between meals, resort guests can enjoy championship golf

at <u>TPC Danzante Bay</u>, world-class fishing, snorkeling, paddle boarding, kayaking, swimming, tennis and hiking. The luxurious <u>Sabila Spa and Wellness Center</u> pampers guests with treatments that gain their inspiration from the soothing plant and herbal extracts native to the Baja California region.

The resort is just a two-hour flight from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) via Alaska Airlines. It's accessible seasonally with direct WestJet flights from Calgary and from destinations within Mexico via Calafia and Volaris Airlines.
