<b>Course Description:</b>	<p>The Preserve Golf Club is a serene golf experience in the natural world, free of distractions – other than the occasional cry of a red-tailed hawk. Located on the southern ridge of Carmel Valley, The Preserve Golf Club rolls over the contours of the natural hills and valleys deep in the wilderness of the Santa Lucia Mountains.</p> <p>Weaving through wide mature oaks, grassy meadows, flowing streams, and ponds, the continuous 18-hole routing captivates golfers with its tranquil ambiance. Many of the holes are downhill, uphill, or a combination, with slopes around most greens.</p> <p>Thanks to the course’s strategically-placed bunkers and quick greens, every approach shot is faced with an engaging challenge. Tee shots can be intimidating when required to carry several dramatic chasms.</p> <p>Breathtaking views are framed by Valley and Coastal Live Oaks, Coastal Redwoods, and Sycamore trees. Common wildlife includes Golden Eagle, Red Tail Hawk, Wild Turkey, Gray Fox, Mule Deer, Bobcat, and the occasional Mountain Lion.</p>
<b>Golf Shop:</b>	<p>An upscale, full-service facility that carries top-of-the-line apparel and equipment.</p>

<b>Dining:</b>	<p>Sustainable, locally sourced ingredients (often harvested from The Preserve’s organic garden) are the highlight of every meal. Morning refreshments and lunch are served daily at the Golf Clubhouse. Indoor and outdoor seating is available, each table offering views of the golf course and the changing colors of sunlight across the landscape.</p>

The Ranch Club Hacienda, a favorite gathering place for friends and family, offers daily continental breakfast with the addition of an a la carte menu on weekends. Dinner is served five nights per week and the menu features fresh ranch style cuisine with flair. Indoor and outdoor seating is available with patio dining in the picturesque courtyard among stunning madrone trees and roaring fire in the outdoor fireplace is a popular seating choice.

**Accommodations:**

The Hacienda has nine guest rooms, each decorated to reflect the casual elegance of the 1920's sporting estate era, and the Gray's Ranch House, which features seven guest rooms and private courtyard, well suited for private gatherings. The Hacienda and Gray's Ranch House are available to members and their guests.

**Recreation:**

Equestrian center; arenas, pasture, expert staff and trails. 100 miles of maintained trails for hiking, biking and riding. Sports Center (fitness center, daily classes, swimming, a slide and water features, tennis, croquet, bocce, horseshoes, enclosed batting cage, and children's activity center). Moore's Lake (18 acres) for canoe, kayak, fishing, swimming, and paddle boards; a large sandy beach, boathouse, and dock. 42 miles of private roads for cycling.

**Real Estate:**

The community is limited to 300 families on 31 square miles, creating a unique living experience. Homes are built in an array of styles and sizes interpreting the California Ranch aesthetic in a modern way to capture the comfort and ease of California's indoor- outdoor living. Owners and guests are treated to 20,000 acres of views. The community and clubs provide abundant services to smooth the rough edges of an adventurous life for everyone. Today, there are 120 completed homes and more under construction.

**Club Membership:**

Private invitation-only Preserve Ranch Club membership is available with the purchase of a Preserve home or home site, and/or a Preserve Golf Club Membership (full equity). The Preserve Golf Club membership is limited to 300 golf members. A limited number of non-equity Preserve National Golf memberships are also available.
